Tourist Visa

American nationals **are required** to obtain a Visa to enter Bolivia as tourists.

Nationals exempt from a Tourist Visa are only required to have a current valid passport with a minimum validity of 6 months. No application form is required. Upon arrival tourists will be issued a temporary visa.

Remarks:

Beginning December 1st 2007, immigration authorities of the Republic of Bolivia will require that citizens of United States of America traveling as tourists to Bolivia have a Visa.

The Visa will be valid for five (5) years from the date of issue and will permit entry to Bolivia for a total of ninety (90) days each year.

A visa holder will be able to use it three (3) times per year for a total stay of ninety (90) days. Only in very special cases will the Bolivian immigration authorities extend the period of stay over ninety (90) days.

The visa application can be completed by mail or in-person at any Bolivian Consulate.

To apply by mail, the user must send the Consular Office all required documents and a pre-paid Fed-Ex envelope with return address in order to obtain their passport once the visa has been issued.

Visas will be issued within forty eight (48) hours from the receipt of the application and pertinent documentation.

If the applicant will be traveling with Bolivian friends or relatives who live in the United States, they may write the letter of invitation specifying the host's address in Bolivia.

If a physician decides that for health reasons the traveler cannot be vaccinated against Yellow Fever, the physician should issue the corresponding certifications.

REQUIREMENTS FOR UNITED STATES CITIZENS TO OBTAIN A TOURIST VISA FOR TRAVEL TO BOLIVIA

Complete the sworn statement for visa application. [Click here to download the form](#). You must also paste a full color passport size picture (80% of the image must be of the face, no glasses)

2. Current American passport, must be valid for at least 6 more months
3. Copy of the hotel reservation or invitation letter from Bolivian friends or relatives indicating the host address (letter where applicable).
4. Round trip ticket or copy of travel itinerary.
5. Bank statement or equivalent that shows economic solvency (a photocopy of Credit Card (front side) will also be accepted).
6. Copy of yellow fever vaccination certificate.
7. Visa fee of one hundred dollars (cash, direct deposit, or money order)

BOLIVIAN CITIZENS THAT HAVE OBTAINED TWICE NATIONALITY "BOLIVIAN AND .FROM OTHER COUNTRY" DO NOT NEED A VISA TO ENTER BOLIVIA. THEY MUST PRESENT A VALID BOLIVIAN ID CARD ALONG WITH THEIR PASSPORT AND YELLOW FEVER CERTIFICATE.

▶ Student Visa

Student Visas are available for those who wish to undertake further or other education in Bolivia.

Requirements:

- 1) A valid passport with a minimum of 6 months prior to expiration
- 2) A letter from the School or University
- 3) One passport type picture
- 4) A fully completed visa application form ([click here](#))
- 5) Payment of a processing fee

Method of Payment:

Payments in the form Money Order for the exact amount are required must be made at the Bank – Commerzbank in Berlin. Account Nr. 266001701 BLZ 100400 00

More Information: The duration of a Student Visa will be the same as the enrollment period for the applicant at the School or University. To file your visa application, please contact the Consulate at (030 2639150) to schedule an appointment.

▶ Specific Purpose Visa

Those who intend to engage in business, work, research, adoptions, marriage or other tasks require a Specific Purpose Visa.

Requirements:

- 1) A valid passport with a minimum of 6 months prior to expiration
- 2) One passport type picture
- 3) A Statement Letter detailing the purpose of your trip
- 4) A fully completed visa application form ([click here](#))
- 5) You may be required to pay a visa/processing fee

Method of Payment:

Payments in the form of Money Order for the exact amount must be made payable at the Bank Commerzbank Berlin, Account Nr. 266001701 BLZ 100 400 00. When applying for a Specific Purpose Visa, a Statement Letter is required. This letter should explain the specific purpose of the journey, the dates of travel and confirmation that expenses will be furnished either by yourself or by the sending or hosting company or institution. ▶ **Transit Visa**

Requirements:

- 1) A valid passport with a minimum of 6 months prior to expiration
- 2) A copy of your travel tickets and your itinerary
- 3) One passport type picture
- 4) A fully completed visa application form ([click here](#))
- 5) You may be required to pay a visa/processing fee

Method of Payment:

▶ **Missionary Visa**

Requirements:

- 1) A valid passport with a minimum of 6 months prior to expiration
- 2) A Certificate from your religious organization
- 3) A Certificate of Police Records
- 4) A copy of your travel tickets and your itinerary
- 5) One passport type picture
- 6) A fully completed visa application form ([click here](#))
- 7) You may be required to pay a visa/processing fee

▶ **Passports for Bolivian Citizens**

The Bolivian Passport is valid for 6 years. If your passport has been lost, stolen or is about to expire, you should apply for a new passport.

Requirements:

- 1) A Valid Bolivian Identity Card
- 2) A previously expired passport
- 3) Two recent passport type photos
- 4) A fully completed passport application form ([click here](#))

▶ **Certificate of Life**

Requirements:

- 1) A Current Passport
- 2) A Valid Bolivian Identity Card
- 3) Proof of your Current Address
- 4) Proof of your Current Field of Employment

The Certificate of Life is a free certificate and it is valid for 3 months.

▶ **Certified Translations to English**

Requirements:

Present the original birth or marriage certificate. Cost: US\$ 9.00
